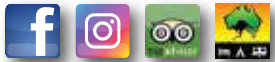

- Check-ins are still available on these days. Phone us prior to arrange.

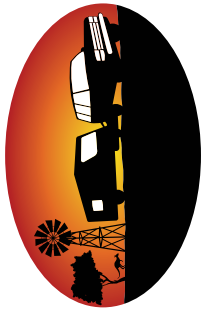

Park Rules & Regulations

For the comfort of all our guests we do have a few rules to follow.

NON-SMOKING— All buildings are non-smoking. It is prohibited to smoke inside & within 10 metres of any public building.

De Fib Machine has been installed on the wall in the Camp Kitchen. Please follow all instructions clearly indicated in the case of a medical episode.

Sites:

Caravans to be parked with towbars facing towards roadway. Motor homes to be reversed into site. Sites to be kept neat & tidy at all times with no temporary clothes lines. Clothes Lines are available at the front of the Guest Laundry & behind the Camp Kitchen. Only one vehicle per site. Additional vehicles to be parked on the street or as pre arranged with Manager. No vehicle/mechanical repairs to be undertaken on site/in the park & no washing of vehicles, motorhomes/trailers/campers on site. There is a car wash available in town.

Speed Limit is walking pace. 10kmh throughout the park at all times. You may be asked to leave if limits are not adhere to. Please be vigilant of foot traffic & children & take extra care when reversing.

We love our furry friends & for everyone's comfort, here are some rules for pet owners to follow. Pets are permitted only at Managers discretion & must be on a leash at all times. All droppings must be collected, wrapped & disposed of in bins provided - no exceptions. Maximum of 2 pets per site/cabin & are only permitted only in pet friendly cabins. They are not permitted in the Camp Kitchen and must not be left unattended ever.

Fire Pits are available for all to use so please follow rules below for the pleasure & safety of all guests.

Fire pits **cannot be lit on a Total Fire Ban Day.** If unsure, please check with Management, Google or phone local Rural Fire Service on (02) 6872 2568. Gas stoves & appliances can be used at any time. Fires can only be lit in the designated fire pits. Wood is available for sale at the office. Never leave the fire burning overnight. Last person to leave fire is responsible for putting it fully out with water.

Sullage hoses can be placed into the gardens (no harsh chemical please). Use a bucket if your hose is not long enough. **BLUE Taps - Drinking Water**
RED Taps - River Water Please do not empty sewerage tanks into toilets.

Personal Conduct & Safety is of the utmost importance. Ensure Children are under adult supervision at all times. Guests are expected to respect the privacy of others & ensure noise is kept to a minimum especially early morning before 6am and after 10pm. This includes keeping voices at a normal volume along with TV's & music. Disorderly, drunken or drug related behaviour will not be tolerated & will result in immediate eviction from the park & the Police will be called. Police randomly drive through the park throughout the day & night. Park Managers have the right to terminate occupancy without explanation. Please remember to lock your vehicles & remove any valuables at night. Parking is at own risk. **LOCK IT OR LOSE IT.** Park Management/Owners accept no responsibility for caravans, tents/swags, vehicles or their contents whilst in the park.

Facilities are provided for your convenience so please treat them with respect & leave it dean & tidy for the next guest. This includes cleaning the BBQ when you're finished.

Check out time is 10am. An extra nights tariff will apply to those who fail to check out on time. If you require a little extra time please speak directly with the Park Manager 24 hours prior to departure & we'll do our utmost to accommodate your request.

Visitors are welcome & must report to the office prior to entering the park. Use the Visitor car parking next to the office or park on the street. Visitors must vacate the park by 10pm.

Swimming Pool is available for all guests to enjoy. Be mindful to keep noise levels to a pleasant level, in particularly Children. No running and jumping into the pool & any Children under 12 within in the pool precinct must be accompanied by an Adult at all times. Unaccompanied Children will be requested to leave the area & persistence may result in the family requested to leave the Park. All rules erected in the Pool area must be adhered to at all times. No glass bottles/receptacles are permitted within the pool precinct & Pool hours are 8am to 10pm.

Evacuation - If this is required, please assemble on the vacant block opposite the front entrance to the park & follow Park Managers & Employees instructions/guidance. To ensure valuable time is not waisted during an evacuation event please do not leave the evacuation area without advising Park Manager.
